

Kairos Christian Academy will hold Open House on June 7th.

Open House consists of a mandatory one-time Program Introduction followed by Passport Completion, which allows parents to meet the teachers, ask questions, make decisions, and finalize registration. All summer homework packets will be distributed at this time. Newcomers can observe and gather information without commitment.

OPEN HOUSE SCHEDULE

Arrival & Passports – Parents are given Passports on arrival to the Open House. Passports must be signed by a leadership team member after a parent attends the Program Introduction. Also, teachers must sign for each of their classes for which a family is registered. At the end of Open House, parents submit their completed Passport, and it is at that moment that a family assumes financial responsibility for tuition for the school year and the Open House deposit is credited toward tuition.

10:00 am: Program Introduction for first time KCA families – Upon joining KCA, each family must attend the Program Introduction one time.

11:00 am: Teacher tables open. This experience is an opportunity for parents to meet the KCA teachers, learn more about the classes, and collect packets for each class in which their child is enrolled. Current KCA families who only need to pick up their class packets are requested to wait to attend Open House at 1:00 PM to prevent overcrowding and allow for a more efficient experience.

12:15 pm: Closed for Lunch

1:00 pm – Teacher tables re-open until 2:30 p.m.

This event is not suitable for young children or elementary aged students.

Those unable to attend the complete Open House must plan to attend a private orientation with packet pickup. The Open House fee will be applied to this occasion.
